INVITATION TO BID

The Patton's Retreat Water Association is soliciting bids for the 2009 Arsenic Treatment Facility Project.

Bids are requested for the installation of a 25 gallon per minute (gpm) pre-fabricated arsenic treatment process, chlorination equipment, miscellaneous building plumbing, and installation and connection of an 14 kWatt emergency generator and connection to the existing propane tank to support the on-site booster pump station.

The contract completion time is ninety (90) calendar days total (see INFORMATION TO BIDDERS).

Sealed bids may be mailed to PO Box 1132, Freeland, WA 98249 or hand delivered to 1796 E. Main Street, Suite 105, Freeland, WA 98249 in accordance with the Information to Bidders. Bids will be received until 11:00 am, Wednesday, November 4, 2009 at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud in the conference room at 1796E. Main Street, Freeland, WA 98249.

Project Manuals with reduced-size plans may be examined or purchased for \$30.00, nonrefundable, at the Engineer's office, 1796 E. Main St, Suite 105, Freeland, WA 98249. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond (with authorized surety as surety) made payable to Patton's Retreat Water Association in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount bid.

No BIDDER may withdraw his bid for a period of 30 calendar days after the date set for the opening thereof.
