SR-520 Montlake to Lake Washington I/C and Bridge Replacement

## INVITATION TO BID

**Bid Date Due: 4.24.20**

### Project Description:

This Bid package is for the demolition of the Montlake Blvd. Bridge over the SR-520 and the 24th Ave. Bridge over the SR-520. Both bridges will need to be fully removed including all superstructures, substructures and foundations. Each bridge will be removed during a full weekend freeway closure (1 closure per bridge). The SR-520 freeway will need to be protected during demolition.

Work is expected to commence July of 2021 (depending on COVID-19 issues).

By submitting a response to this Subtrade Bid Request (a "Bid"), the party submitting the Bid (the "Subcontractor") agrees with the Graham entity described herein ("Graham") that:

1. The Bid will be irrevocable for 30 days from the date that Graham is required to submit its reply to the Owner's RFP/Tender (the "RFP"), or for the irrevocability period described in the RFP, whichever is longer.
2. The Subcontractor's price detailed in the Bid is sufficient to cover the risks described in Graham's Standard Subcontract and Terms and Conditions, copies of which can be accessed online at: <http://grahambuilds.com/subcontracts> (the "Subcontract"), and all risks related to the scope of work the Subcontractor will be required to perform if its Bid is successful.
3. If Graham awards a subcontract to the Subcontractor, the Subcontractor will:
  - a. execute the Subcontract without any changes;

- b. If the value of the subcontract is equal to or greater than \$200,000, provide a Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Bond (both in an amount and form acceptable to Graham); provide an Irrevocable Letter of Credit (in an amount and form acceptable to Graham); or qualify for Graham's Subcontract Default Insurance Program\*; and
- c. If its Bid includes any qualifications, exceptions, proposed substitutions or proposed amendments ("Proposed Exceptions") to these Instructions or the Subcontract, waive the Proposed Exceptions in their entirety.
