Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Kennewick Irrigation District (District) at the District's office (12 West Kennewick Avenue, Kennewick, WA 98336) or via mail until 2:00 pm on December 20, 2013 for construction of the Red Mountain South LID, 1070 Reservoir. Bids will then be opened, read and tabulated publicly. Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered.

The Red Mountain South LID, 1070 Reservoir project consists of the construction of a 100,000 gallon welded steel reservoir and installation of approximately 1,250 linear feet of 8-inch irrigation main. Work includes, but is not limited to, site and access road development, rock excavation, detention pond and control structures, pond liner, structural concrete, structural steel, mechanical, electrical and control. The Engineer's probable construction cost estimate for this project is from \$875,000 to \$1,100,000.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at the District's office on December 9, 2013, at 10:00 am.
