Increased DBE Focus - WSDOT

- WSDOT's AWW program dedicated additional resources to DBE program
 - Full time AWW DBE Program Manager, Dawn McIntosh
 - Focus on fulfilling the intent as much as meeting the DBE goal
 - Monthly utilization reports verified within three weeks
 - Increased tracking of DBE firms
- Full time DBE Administrator, Bobby Forch working the following issues as they develop:
 - Single point of contact for all DBE firms
 - Conducts community outreach
 - Makes recommendations to remove barriers to DBE participation
- Tracking and status phone conference every Monday at noon – lead by Chief Engineer, Linea Laird





Purpose: Construct new ramps and other connections at the south end of the SR 99 tunnel.


Estimated Cost: ~\$36 million

(as a percentage of the total construction cost)




South Access Connection Footprint

South Access Schedule and Coordination



- Ad & construction schedule are dependent on SR 99 tunnel opening date.
- Contractor and sub-contractor's will be required to continually coordinate with tunnel design-build contractor to avoid workzone conflicts prior to tunnel opening.
- Workzones will be shared or transferred between the South Access Connections contractor and the design-build contractor based on coordinated milestone dates.
