## Request for Qualifications North Willapa Shoreline Erosion Mitigation Master Plan Pacific County, Washington

Pacific County is seeking Request for Qualifications (RFQ) from qualified individuals or firms for assistance in the development of a master plan to catalog current and proposed initiatives and research projects, identify gaps and potential synergies across these programs, seek to connect and align stakeholder efforts, and propose opportunities for collaboration across the many opportunities to mitigate coastal flooding, storm surge, and erosion damage across the north Willapa Bay shoreline.

The Master Plan will indirectly enable the following:

- Improve sediment delivery down drift of the SR 105 groin/dike to replenish rapidly deteriorating beach, wetland, and estuarine critical habitat.
- Establish a stable post-construction shoreline shape to minimize erosional hotspots near existing public utility infrastructure, state highway, public recreation areas, drainage systems, tribal land, and private structures.
- Reduce coastal storm damage from flooding, sand over-wash and debris on SR 105; reduce risk of North Entrance Channel migration toward SR 105.
- Assemble and coordinate data and analysis to inform appropriate management measures
  that can be incorporated into the Pacific County Hazard Mitigation Plan, Comprehensive
  Plan, Critical Areas Ordinance, Shoreline Master Program, and Risk MAP.
