Public notice is hereby given that the City of Lynnwood, Washington has issued the above-referenced request for bids. Complete bid documents are available at <https://www.lynnwoodwa.gov/Government/City-Clerk/Procurement-Contracts-Division> under Bids & Proposals, Current Contracting Opportunities on the lower right side of the page. Bidders will be required to create a FREE account with OpenGov (formally ProcureNow) to download and submit bids.

The .65-acre park site work includes, but not limited to a new concrete plaza, paver plaza, and walking paths, concrete retaining wall and seatwalls, footing/foundation for the Gold Star Families Memorial Monument, minor drainage, electrical conduit, site grading, soil preparation, channelization, permanent signing, and installation of City-purchased site furnishings.

Engineer's Estimate: \$274,403 to \$320,137.

Pre-Bid Site Visit: An optional site visit is scheduled for Thursday, June 2, 2022, at 10:30 am. See OpenGov.com website for details. The site location is open for viewing at any time.

Time for Completion: Project must be complete or substantially complete by November 1, 2022.
