

CERTIFICATION: What Comes Next?



FEDERAL CERTIFICATION

90 Days - 49.C.F.R.26.83(k)

Site Visit - Mandatory

STATE CERTIFICATION

60 Days - WAC 326-20-130

Site Visit - Not Mandatory

STEP 1

Submit application for Federal or State Certification. Businesses may apply for both programs.

STEP 2

Exchange documents and information during the review period

STEP 3

Federal applications require a site visit

STEP 4

Analyst works through the application (answers questions about eligibility, ownership, control, independence, and business size. This step typically takes the most time.)

STEP 5

OMWBE notifies applicant of certification decision. (If yes, we send an approval email with the certification letter. If no, we send a denial letter with appeal rights.)

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Acronyms:

C.F.R. - Code of Federal Regulations

NAICS - North America Industry Classification System

USDOT - United States Department of Transportation

WAC - Washington Administrative Code

ELIGIBILITY

- Social Disadvantage: Owner of 51% or more MUST be a member of a "presumptively disadvantaged group" (Federal (minority and/or woman), State (minority, and/or woman, and/or LGBTQ); if not presumed disadvantaged, an applicant owner may be deemed disadvantaged on a case-by-case basis.
- Economic Disadvantage: Owner of 51% or more MUST have a personal net worth of \$2.047 million or less. (49 CFR § 26.67; WAC 326-20-049)

OWNERSHIP

- Business MUST be at least 51% owned by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals. (49 CFR § 26.69; WAC 326-20-050)

CONTROL

Eligible individual MUST:

- Control the business
- Have experience/knowledge of the business's industry
- Be independent - must not depend on any other business to exist or continue operations. (49 CFR § 26.65; WAC 326-20-099)

SIZE

- Must be a small business (size below NAICS code amount AND statutory amount, \$31.84 million) (49 CFR § 26.65; WAC 326-20-099)
