Program Overview

The Skanska Seattle CMBB program is scheduled to meet twice per week for 10 sessions and 5 weeks. The coaching sessions will be from 4:00PM until 6:00PM starting February 16th through March 18th. Classes will be held virtually through Zoom. Attendees are women owned, diverse and small businesses, vendors and suppliers.

The goal of the program is to provide coaching and a better understanding of how to be successful on construction projects with large prime contractors. The process involves training from Skanska leadership and Operations from our Seattle office. Some of the additional benefits of the program are the networking with other contractors in the class and the relationships with the instructors from Skanska.

The program addresses topics that have been identified as traditional challenges for many Certified contractors. Participants will find the format to include lecture, group discussions, and hands-on demonstrations with proven business practices. Course material will be presented by internal and external Skanska subject experts from our Seattle office. Topics include diverse certification basics, sustainability, bidding, insurance, prequalification, scheduling, billing, safety, and closeout.
