Purpose: OMWBE is the sole certifying agency for small minority, women, and socially and economically disadvantaged business enterprises. OMWBE has both a state and federal certification program with similar rules. On April 9, 2024, the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) announced that the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) and Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) rules will change and become effective on May 9, 2024. The USDOT rules are codified in 49 CFR Parts 23 and 26 and used for OMWBE's federal certification. To align OMWBE's state certification program with its federal program, OMWBE proposes changes to the above-listed Certification rules, which are found in Chapter 326-20.
