

LOT- K58 - Vehicle Wraps

Amendment 1 – Questions and Answers

1. Would the Lottery entertain bids from anyone outside of the 15 mile radius if they're willing to pick up/drop off and provide insurance for this?

The Lottery will accept bid responses outside of the 15 miles radius if 100% of the pick-up and drop off transportation is supplied by the vendor. Vendor must be insured for this type of transportation.

If pick up and drop off is not offered by vendor, than vendor must be located within 15 miles of the Lottery Headquarters as outlined in the RFQQ.

Wraps can be either full or partial wraps and largely depends on the color vehicle we get from the state motor pool. Hoods commonly have our Lottery Logo, the roof is not usually wrapped.
