Floodplain Scale Remote Sensing Pilot Project - Western WA

PROPOSAL DUE DATE: June 25, 2021 – 3:00 pm, Local Time, Olympia WA

1. Is data collection expected in 2021?

Analysis of available data may be asked of the contractor, but data collection is not expected in 2021.

2. Is the list of sites included in the RFQQ exhaustive?

The site list included in the RFQQ is a draft list, and is not exhaustive. If there are other projects that meet the requirements and criteria for monitoring, they could be considered for potential sites, provided there is documented communication between the contractor, project sponsor(s) and monitoring panel.

3. Are there existing DEM and shape files available for the PRISM projects?

No. Project locations and coordinates can be [searched on the RCO web site](#).

4. How defined must the schedule be?

Debris torrents and flood events may not happen in the first season, and the 'schedule' should address this. There are work product deliverables that will have target dates established.

5. Is RCO seeking a schedule narrative for capabilities to meet deadlines or should the contractor provide actual dates?

RCO is looking for details on how the project will be laid out and implemented based on the study plan.

6. Is survey method experience required?

Experience is not required but a familiarity with survey methods is preferred.
