

Steps your agency has completed to prepare for forecasting and steps remaining: Completed: The Department has developed an annual coordination between the Budget Office and Procurement & Contracts Unit that establishes planned procurement and contract actions as included in division biennium budgets. This effort is the first step in the development of the Departments procurement and contracting forecast efforts. By working with all divisions to identify anticipated procurements, we can then build our annual forecast report for placement on our Department's outward facing website.
