

DNR staff have worked diligently over the last year to provide feedback to DES on the Supplier Diversity Policy and then implementation of the policy and handbook in the agency. Currently over 1400 DNR staff have completed the DES Supplier Diversity training in the learning center with steps taken with our learning center administrators to continue to assign training to new staff. We have updated our solicitations, contracts, and guidance documents for compliance of the new policy. We look forward to seeing how our efforts increase DNRs diverse spend over fiscal year 24.
