Agency's plan to increase participation of small minority-, women- and veteran-owned firms:

- 1. For procurements under the direct buy limit (\$10,000 if not with OMWBE-certified firm, \$13,000 if with an OMWBE-certified firm), review the OMWBE's Directory of Certified Firms and the Department of Veteran Affairs' website to identify certified firms for items we purchase.
- 2. Use Washington Electronic Business Solution (WEBS) for all our requests for quotes and requests for proposals over the direct buy limits, which will notify certified firms.
- 3. Purchasing and Contracts staff will work with DES to identity minority-, women- and/or veteran-owned businesses, particularly for our public works projects.
- 4. Work with DES to identify general contractors who use certified sub-contractors for public works.
- 5. Communicate through training to office staff our additional \$3000 purchase authority when buying from minority-, women- and/or veteran-owned businesses.
- 6. Look for master contracts with minority-, women- and/or veteran-owned businesses using the DES website.
- 7. Encourage minority-, women- and/or veteran-owned vendors we use to become certified.
- 8. Create a list of contacts to assist with diversity outreach efforts.
- 9. On the OSOS procurement website, direct non-certified firms to OWMBE to encourage them to become certified.
